PROGRAMS:

Junior Bulldogs **Grades K- 3**
9:00 am – 12 noon **\$160 per child**
Week of July 6 – 10
Participants will be introduced to fundamental soccer skills as well as learning the basic aspects of the game. The joy and fun of playing soccer is this camp's primary focus.

Bulldogs **Grades 3-8**
9:00 am – 12 noon **\$160 per child**
Session #1 July 6 – 10
Session #2 July 13 – 17
Session #3 August 3 – 7
These coed sessions are designed to enhance player development by building fundamental skills and an overall understanding of the game of soccer. Play will be divided according to age and ability. Possession, one-on-one attacking and defending skills, small sided games, as well as team play and goal tending will be a focus. You may register for multiple sessions.

Striker/Keeper Camp **Grades 3-8**
9:00 am – 12 noon **\$160 per child**
Session #1 July 13 – 17
Session #2 August 3 – 7
The striker camp is designed to help players develop the skills and instincts needed to be a goal scorer. While the focus is on the striker, any other positional player would benefit from learning the skills needed to be a dangerous attacking player.
The goalkeeper camp will offer specific training for a goalkeeper to develop confidence, leadership, and the mental toughness needed in order to become a consistent goalie. The goalkeeper camp is run in conjunction with the striker camp to provide goalkeepers with multiple shots on goal.

Technical Training Camp **Grades 7-12**
\$160 per child

Girls Session **M & W 7:30am – 9:00am**
Boys Session **M & W 6:30pm to 8:00pm**
July 6 – August 5
This 5-week training camp meets twice per week and will focus on technical training and game play for middle school and high school level players. Each training session will be divided into two components: a specialized skill training circuit followed by small sided or full sided game play. Sessions will be conducted by HV High School soccer coaches Jeff Neuman, Ed Gola, and Dan Balog.

Bulldog Conditioning Camp **Grades 9-12**
9:00 am – 11:30 am **\$125 per child**
Week of August 10 – 13
This pre-season coed conditioning camp for middle school and high school students places an emphasis on fitness, agility, speed, endurance and strength. Conditioning with the soccer ball, as well as small sided games, will be great training for players hoping to compete on the interscholastic level.
