Mr. Pogorzelski,

Since 1990, Hopewell Township's population has grown 153 percent. Since 2000 there has been an 18 percent increase in residential and commercial electric demand in Hopewell Township. In order to address these increased supply needs and improve the electric supply reliability, PSE&G is upgrading the electric power supply to this area.

The project will involve installing underground manholes and conduits from the existing Mt. Rose Substation to Pennington/Rocky Hill Road eastward thru the Mt Rose intersection to an existing riser pole located on Cherry Valley Road approximately 620 feet east of Aunt Molly Road. This work will be performed during the summer months and will require road closures including traffic control. We will continue to work closely with your staff, including the Police and Public Works Departments, and the Mercer County DOT to develop detailed traffic control plans to minimize the impact of this construction.
