NOTICE OF PROPOSED INCREASE IN REMEDIATION ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS THEREON

TO OUR CUSTOMERS: On March 15, 2011, Jersey Central Power & Light Company ("JCP&L" or the "Company") filed a Verified Petition with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (the "Board") Board, under BPU Docket No. ER11030141, together with supporting attachments.

The Verified Petition provides for a reconciliation of the actual costs and collections during 2010 under the Company's Remediation Adjustment Clause ("RAC") Tariff Rider. The Verified Petition also provides for an assessment of the anticipated future level of expenses to be recovered through Rider RAC and the need for changes after 2010 in the level of collections thereunder. In the Verified Petition, JCP&L is requesting to increase collections under Rider RAC, which funds the remediation of former manufactured gas plant sites, by approximately \$1.1 million annually. The change in rates would become effective on March 1, 2012 or on such date as the Board may determine.

The annual percentage change in rates, if any, applicable to specific customers will vary according to the applicable rate schedule and the level of the customer's usage. Copies of the Verified Petition, together with supporting attachments, are available for inspection at the Company's regional headquarters at 300 Madison Avenue, Morristown, New Jersey 07962 and 331 Newman Springs Road, Building 3, Red Bank, New Jersey 07701, at each of the Company's local business offices, and at the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities, 44 South Clinton Street, 9th Floor, P.O. Box 350, Trenton, New Jersey 08625-0350.

The following comparisons of present and proposed rates will permit customers to determine the approximate net effect upon them of the proposed increase in charges of \$1.1 million annually. Any assistance required by customers in this regard will be furnished by the Company upon request.
