I am writing on behalf of Homeowners Against Land Taking-PennEast (HALT) to support the New Jersey Conservation Foundation (NJCF) and Stony Brook-Millstone Watershed Association's (SBMWA) Rule 206 Complaint and Rule 212 Motion¹ for an evidentiary hearing on the question of market need for PennEast Pipeline Company's proposed pipeline (FERC Docket No. CP-15-558). HALT is a non-profit organization comprised of more than 300 homeowners in New Jersey's Hunterdon and Mercer Counties and several counties in Pennsylvania whose homes and farms lie within the proposed pipeline's pathway and who could be impacted by the proposed pipeline. HALT has reviewed NJCF and SBMWA's Rule 206 Complaint and Rule 212 Motion and agrees that based on PennEast's particular circumstances, an evidentiary hearing is necessary to resolve the narrow question of whether there is demonstrated market need for PennEast's pipeline, as required by the Natural Gas Act, 15 U.S.C. § 717f.
