Trip Policy

Trips are open to Hopewell Township residents, their guests, and residents of our neighboring communities. All community trips include motor coach transportation and depart from Independence Park adjacent to Stony Brook Elementary School in Brandon Farms. Trips have limited enrollment and you are encouraged to sign up early. Bus driver gratuities are not included in the registration fee.

Program Fee: denotes the cost per person of each program.

HT RES: denotes discounted program fee for Hopewell Township Residents only.

Refund Policy for Community Trips:

Refunds and/or account credits will only be offered if requested in writing and the trip has refundable tickets. This will depend on the destination of the trip. **Broadway show tickets are always non-refundable.** If tickets are non-refundable, credits will only be issued if there is a waitlist for the trip. Exceptions will be reviewed upon request. A \$35 administrative fee will be deducted from all refunds granted.



The Franklin Institute

Wednesday, 4/5.....9am –4:30pm

Program Fee: \$45.....HT Fee: \$40

(Bus Fee ONLY—Tickets for the museum need to be purchased on your own, through the Franklin Institute website or day of trip.)

We will be heading to Philadelphia to enjoy all the Franklin Institute has to offer! This trip, over Hopewell Valley School District's Spring Break, has something for everyone! General Admission to The Franklin Institute includes access to three floors of hands-on



science exhibits and a show at the Planetarium. Also, *Disney 100: The Exhibition* will be opening at the end of February and is a must see! Disney has curated special behind-the-scenes glimpses into the creation of the company's most popular characters, films, shows, and attractions—from Disneyland to Walt Disney World and beyond. Visitors will be taken on a journey through 100 years of The Walt Disney Company. Tickets for the Disney exhibit with General Admission are \$45 and \$41 for children (ages 3-11). General admission (without the Disney exhibit) is \$25 and \$21 (ages 3-11). We recommend you purchase your admission tickets prior to day of trip. Fonthill Castle & Mercer Museum

Wednesday, 4/26.....8:45am-5:30pm

Program Fee: \$97 **HT RES: \$87**

Our day will begin at the home of Henry Chapman Mercer at Fonthill Castle (built between 1908-1912). The Castle was Mercer's showplace for his collection of tiles and prints. It is an early example of reinforced concrete and features forty-four rooms, over two hundred windows, and eighteen fireplaces. 



We will be treated to a one-hour guided tour as well as

have time to explore the grounds on our own. Next we will head to the Plumsteadville Inn where we will enjoy lunch together as a group. After lunch, we will complete our day with a trip to the Mercer Museum, where we will have an orientation of the museum and time for a self-guided tour to see the exhibits as well as the core museum collection of over 50,000 pre-Industrial tools. The museum is also famous for the unique way that artifacts are displayed throughout its Central Court as if suspended in mid-air. Trip price includes bus transportation, admission to the Castle and Museum, as well as lunch.

Everyday Rhythms will be on exhibit at the Mercer Museum during our trip!



Adult Programs

Program Policy

ALL of our programs (children, adult, and senior) are open to Hopewell Township residents, and residents of our neighboring communities of Pennington, Hopewell Borough, and beyond.

All programs have limited enrollment and you are encouraged to sign up early!

Program Fees: Some of our programs offer a higher fee for NON Hopewell Township Residents, while others are the same price regardless of residency. This is determined by a variety of factors. If two different fees are charged, there will be two prices listed, one as **Program Fee** and one as **HT RES.** **HT RES** denotes a lower rate for Hopewell Township Residents only. (Hopewell Township Residents are residents who pay their taxes to Hopewell Township.) If you are not sure if you are a Hopewell Township Resident, call our office at 609-737-3753 and we can determine your residency.

Refund Policy for Community Programs: Program fees will only be refunded if requested in writing three weeks prior to the start of the program. An account credit will be issued for cancellations less than three weeks. Once a program begins, there will be no refund or credit given. Exceptions will be reviewed upon requests. A \$35 administrative fee will be deducted from all refunds granted.

Canceled Programs: Hopewell Recreation has the right to cancel a program at any time. If a class is canceled during the season, every effort will be made to offer a make-up class. If the program is canceled for the season by Hopewell Recreation, full refunds will be given.

Program Fees

If two different fees are charged, there will be two prices listed, one as **Program Fee** and one as **HT RES.** **HT RES** denotes a lower rate for Hopewell Township Residents only. (Hopewell Township Residents are residents who pay their taxes to Hopewell Township.) If you are not sure if you are a Hopewell Township Resident, call our office at 609-737-3753 and we can confirm it for you.



Refund Policy

Refund Policy for camps and clinics differs from our typical program refund policy. Please familiarize yourself with the policy prior to registering for camps and clinics.

Refund requests MUST be made in writing or through email—refund amount will be determined by the number of days prior to the start of the program that notification is received.

* 45 + days = Full Refund—\$35 Admin. fee

If you withdraw less than 45 days from the start of the camp or clinic, you will either receive a percentage of your paid fee or will receive full refund -\$35 admin. fee (whichever is less). Percentage fees will be calculated by the price of the camp or clinic and will be as follows:

* 15-44 days = 75% refund

* 6-14 days = 50% refund

* 1-5 days = 25% refund

* No refund once camp begins

Late Registration Policy

Each program has a deadline for registration and payment. A **\$35 late fee** will be assessed to all registrations accepted past the deadline.
