**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, IN THE COUNTY OF
MERCER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REQUESTING A COST SHARE
AGREEMENT BETWEEN NJDOT AND THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL FOR
TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS TO THE INGLESIDE AVENUE (CR631) AND
ROUTE 31 INTERSECTION**

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell has requested the installation of a full traffic signal at the intersection of Ingleside Avenue (CR631) and Route 31; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation responded by requesting a 25% cost-sharing agreement to be signed by the Township of Hopewell and a Resolution of Support be submitted from the County of Mercer; and

WHEREAS, the Hopewell Township Committee believes this project to be in the best interest of the community as it will make the intersection safer.

WHEREAS, as per NJDOT Policy 346, the Township is willing to contribute up to a 25% cost share for these projects.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of Hopewell does request the NJDOT's Bureau of Traffic Engineering to complete the warrant analysis and design work for the installation of a full traffic signal Ingleside Avenue (CR631) and Route 31 intersection if warranted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hopewell, County of Mercer and State of New Jersey that:

1. A copy of this resolution be forwarded to the County of Mercer Engineer and the New Jersey Department of Transportation.
2. This resolution was passed unanimously by the Township Committee.
3. This resolution was supported by many residents of Ingleside Avenue (CR631).
