**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, IN THE COUNTY OF  
MERCER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REQUESTING TRAFFIC SAFETY  
IMPROVEMENTS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF  
PENNINGTON-HARBOURTON RD (CR634) AND SCOTCH ROAD &  
PENNINGTON-TITUSVILLE ROAD AND SCOTCH ROAD**

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee of the Township of Hopewell, as well as Township residents, have expressed concern regarding traffic safety at the intersections of Pennington-Harbourton Rd (CR634) and Scotch Rd. & Pennington-Titusville Rd. and Scotch Rd.; and

**WHEREAS**, numerous vehicle crashes have been documented at both intersections, several of which resulted in injuries and a tragic fatality; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of Hopewell Township considers the safety of pedestrians, cyclists and motorists to be of the utmost importance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hopewell Township Committee believes that traffic safety improvements should be studied at both intersections including, but not limited to, the potential for all-way stop control, reduced speed zones approaching the intersections, enhanced warning signage and markings, and/or stop beacons.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Township Committee of Hopewell does request that the County of Mercer Department of Engineering and Township of Hopewell cooperatively investigate the potential for traffic safety improvements that will ensure public safety.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hopewell that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Mercer County Commissioners.
