**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
THE WATERSHED INSTITUTE TO CONDUCT
A SOLSTICE TRAIL RUN 2024**

WHEREAS, application has been made by the Watershed Institute to conduct a 2024 Solstice Trail Run and Festival in the Township of Hopewell at the Watershed Institute, 31 Titus Mill Road on June 20, 2024, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Hopewell Township Health Officer, the Hopewell Township Police Department, and Hopewell Township Bureau of Fire Safety have reviewed the application and granted their approval to conduct the festival and recommend the granting of a permit pursuant to the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Hopewell, Chapter IV, Section 4-3 Festivals and Large Assemblies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. This Resolution shall constitute a permit to conduct a 2024 Solstice Trail Run and Festival in accordance with the application submitted by the Watershed Institute, which festival is to be held on June 20, 2024 at the Watershed Institute, 31 Titus Mill Road in Hopewell Township.

2. The Watershed Institute shall be exempted from the several provisions of 4-3, et seq. (4-3.8 Exemptions. a. Charitable or non-profit organizations) except those provided by 4-3.4, Insurance Requirement.


3. As advised by the Fire Official, the applicant will obtain the necessary permits for the use of fire pits, a 40x60 tent, and electric oven.
