**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
MERCER COUNTY 4-H TO CONDUCT A 4-H FAIR**

WHEREAS, application has been made by the Mercer County 4-H to conduct a 4-H Fair in the Township of Hopewell at Howell Living History Farm on July 27, 2024 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. and July 28, 2024 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Hopewell Township Health Officer, the Hopewell Township Police Department and the Hopewell Township Bureau of Fire Safety have reviewed the application and granted their approval to conduct the festival and recommend the granting of a permit pursuant to the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Hopewell, Chapter IV, Section 4-3 Festivals and Large Assemblies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. This Resolution shall constitute a permit to conduct a 4-H Fair in accordance with the application submitted by Mercer County 4-H, which festival is to be held on July 27 and 28, 2024 at Howell Living History Farm in Hopewell Township.
2. Mercer County 4-H shall be exempted from the several provisions of 4-3, et seq. (4-3.8 Exemptions. a. Charitable or non-profit organizations) except those provided by 4-3.4, Insurance Requirement.
3. As advised by the Fire Official and Health Officer, the applicant will obtain the necessary permits and pre-operation inspection for the use of tents, mobile, use of open flames, and food facilities.
