**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF  
UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF MERCER AND HOPEWELL  
TOWNSHIP FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF AN AMBULANCE**

**WHEREAS**, Mercer County has been awarded American Rescue Plan Act (hereinafter “ARPA”) funds; and

**WHEREAS**, Hopewell Township is in need of an ambulance to meet increasing emergency service needs; and

**WHEREAS**, Mercer County has expressed a desire to disburse State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) to Hopewell Township to procure said ambulance; and


**WHEREAS**, both public entities are interested in entering into a Memorandum of Understanding to memorialize each party’s respective responsibilities concern the funding to purchase an ambulance to assist the Township’s emergency service needs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hopewell, that the Mayor be authorized to sign a Memorandum of Understanding between Mercer County and the Township of Hopewell for the purchase of a new ambulance to meet the Township’s emergency service needs.
