**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE COUNTY
OF MERCER AND THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL FOR MAINTENANCE OF
PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK**

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell is in need of a Memorandum of Understanding with the County of Mercer to set forth the duties, responsibilities and obligations, related to the maintenance, of a pedestrian crosswalk, including flashing/illuminated warnings (in form of rectangular rapid flashing beacons, or RRFBs) and warning/regulatory signage by the crossing of Lawrenceville-Pennington Road (Mercer County Route 546) on the east side of the intersection of Old Pennington-Lawrenceville Road with Lawrenceville-Pennington Road (Mercer County Route 546) to be completely located on lands owned by the COUNTY; and

WHEREAS, the agreement shall be effective upon signing by all parties and shall be for an initial term of ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, this agreement shall automatically renew for a period of five (5) year intervals after the initial ten (10) year term unless the parties mutually agree in writing to cancel or amend it.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the attached Memorandum of Understand between the County of Mercer and Hopewell Township for the maintenance of the above-mentioned pedestrian crosswalk.
