WHEREAS, in 1993, he was promoted to Foreman of the Pennington Fire Company, and served as Assistant Fire Chief from 1996 to 1997, followed by his service as Deputy Fire Chief from 1997 to 1998; and

WHEREAS, in 1998, Matthew G. Martin was appointed as an Emergency Services Specialist with the Hopewell Township Fire District, marking the beginning of a series of key leadership roles, including Senior Emergency Services Specialist in 2004, Fire Official in 2004, Acting Director of Emergency Services in 2004, and finally Fire Captain in 2005; and

WHEREAS, in 2007, he was promoted to Fire Chief of Emergency Services, a position in which he served with distinction for seventeen years, until his retirement in December 2024; and


WHEREAS, throughout his career, Fire Chief Matthew G. Martin demonstrated a profound dedication to public safety, community service, and the well-being of all citizens; and
