**RESOLUTION TO CANCEL TAX BALANCES ON PILOT ACCOUNTS**

**WHEREAS**, The Township of Hopewell has entered into agreements with Beigene Hopewell Urban Renewal and Woodmont Federal Hopewell Urban Renewal under PILOT agreements; and

**WHEREAS**, these individual units are taxed at 100% of the Township tax rate for those months they are without a Certificate of Occupancy, and, after receiving their Certificate of Occupancy, these units are removed from the tax levy and placed under their PILOT billing arrangement; and

**WHEREAS**, taxes on these properties are currently assessed for the entire calendar year; taxes should be cancelled for the periods under which they are billed as PILOTS.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, on this 16<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2024 by the Township Committee of the Township of Hopewell, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, that taxes are to be cancelled by the Tax Collector on those properties receiving their Certificate of Occupancy, based on a percentage determined by the date of the Certificate of Occupancy as provided to the Tax Collector by the Township of Hopewell Construction Department; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution continues until the completion of construction of these units.
