**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
THE SOURLAND CONSERVANCY TO CONDUCT
THE SOURLAND SPECTACULAR FESTIVAL**

WHEREAS, application has been made by the Sourland Conservancy to conduct the Sourland Spectacular Festival in the Township of Hopewell at the Watershed Institute, 31 Titus Mill Road on September 13, 2025, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Hopewell Township Health Officer, the Hopewell Township Police Department, and Hopewell Township Bureau of Fire Safety have reviewed the application and granted their approval to conduct the festival and recommend the granting of a permit pursuant to the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Hopewell, Chapter IV, Section 4-3 Festivals and Large Assemblies.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. This Resolution shall constitute a permit to conduct a festival in accordance with the application submitted by the Sourland Conservancy, which festival is to be held on September 13, 2025 at the Watershed Institute, 31 Titus Mill Road in Hopewell Township.
2. The Sourland Conservancy shall be exempted from the several provisions of 4-3, et seq. (4-3.8 Exemptions. a. Charitable or non-profit organizations) except those provided by 4-3.4, Insurance Requirement.
3. All Mobile Food Truck Facilities shall be licensed by the Municipal Clerk and receive their permits from the Health Department and Fire Bureau no later than two (2) weeks prior to the event.
4. The Municipal Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Watershed Institute, 31 Titus Mill Road, Pennington, NJ 08534.
