**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
THE WATERSHED INSTITUTE
TO CONDUCT A BUTTERFLY FESTIVAL**

WHEREAS, application has been made by the Watershed Institute to conduct a Butterfly Festival in the Township of Hopewell at 31 Titus Mill Road on August 2, 2025, between the hours of 9:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Hopewell Township Police Department reviewed the application and granted approval to conduct the festival and recommend the granting of a permit pursuant to the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Hopewell, Chapter IV, Section 4-3 Festivals and Large Assemblies;

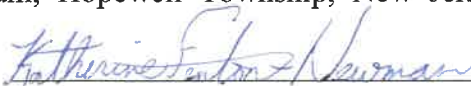
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. Issuance of this permit shall be pending approval from the Hopewell Township Health Officer and the Hopewell Township Bureau of Fire Safety.
2. This Resolution shall constitute a permit to conduct a Butterfly Festival in accordance with the application submitted by the Watershed Institute, which festival is to be held on August 2, 2025 at 31 Titus Mill Road in Hopewell Township.
3. The Watershed Institution shall be exempt from the several provisions of 4-3, et seq. (4-3.8 Exemptions. a. Charitable or non-profit organizations) except those provided by 4-3.4, Insurance Requirement.
4. All Mobile Food Truck Facilities shall be licensed by the Municipal Clerk and receive their permits from the Health Department and Fire Bureau no later than two (2) weeks prior to the event.
5. The Municipal Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Watershed Institute, 31 Titus Mill Road, Pennington, NJ 08534.
