**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL TO ENTER
INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE CITY OF TRENTON,
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE CASE
MANAGEMENT SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Hopewell Township Health Department ("Hopewell") and the City of Trenton, Department of Health ("Trenton") have prepared a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") regarding the delivery of public health nurse case management services for childhood lead poisoning; and

WHEREAS, the MOU outlines a collaborative relationship wherein Trenton will provide case management services to lead-burdened children within Hopewell's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Hopewell Township Committee has reviewed the terms and conditions of the MOU and finds it to be in the best interest of the health and welfare of the residents of Hopewell Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes to authorize the Township Health Officer to execute the MOU on behalf of the Township of Hopewell.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this 11th day of August 2025, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hopewell, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, that the Township's Health Officer is hereby authorized to execute the Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Trenton, Department of Health.
