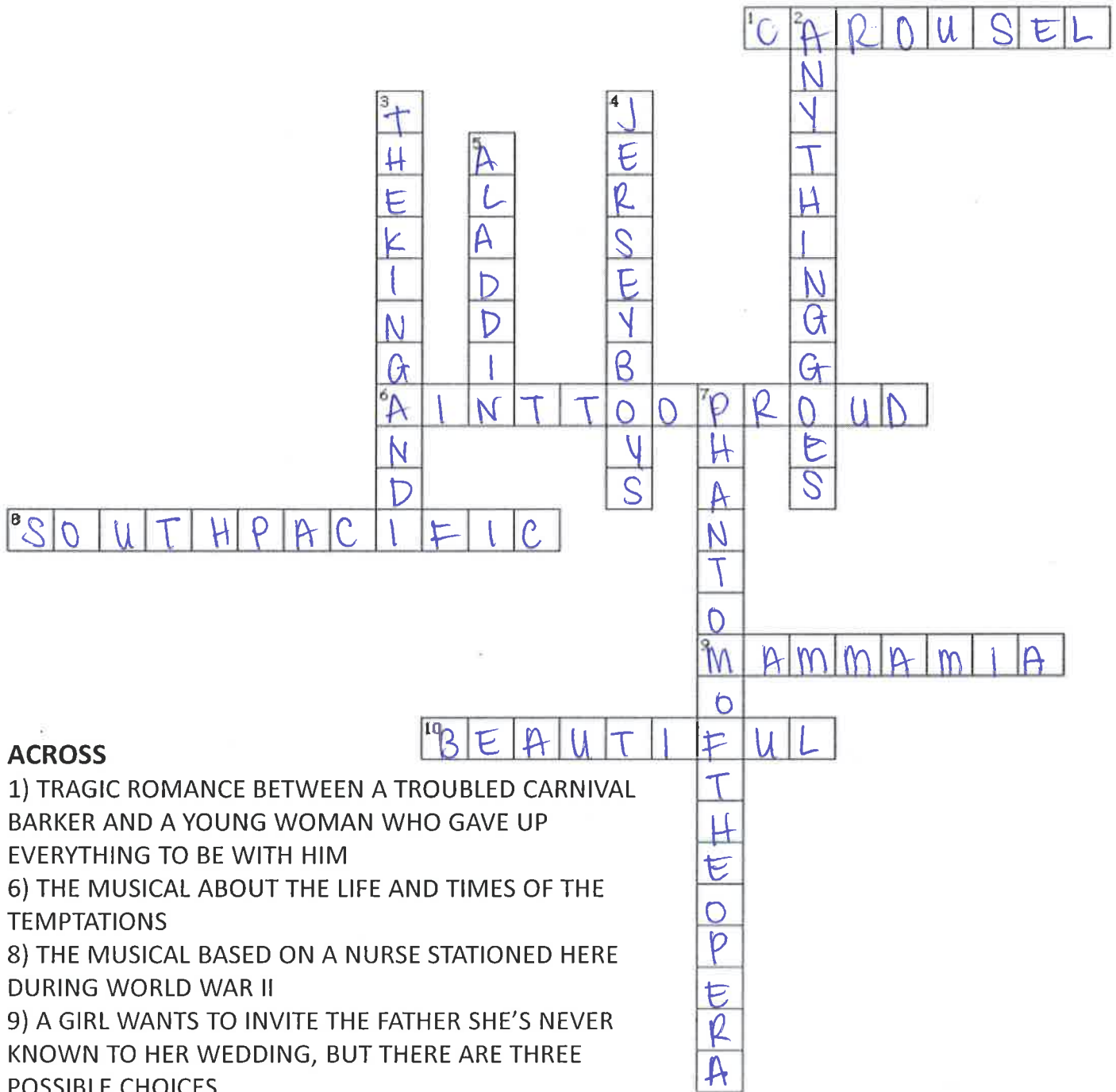


BROADWAY SHOW CROSSWORD

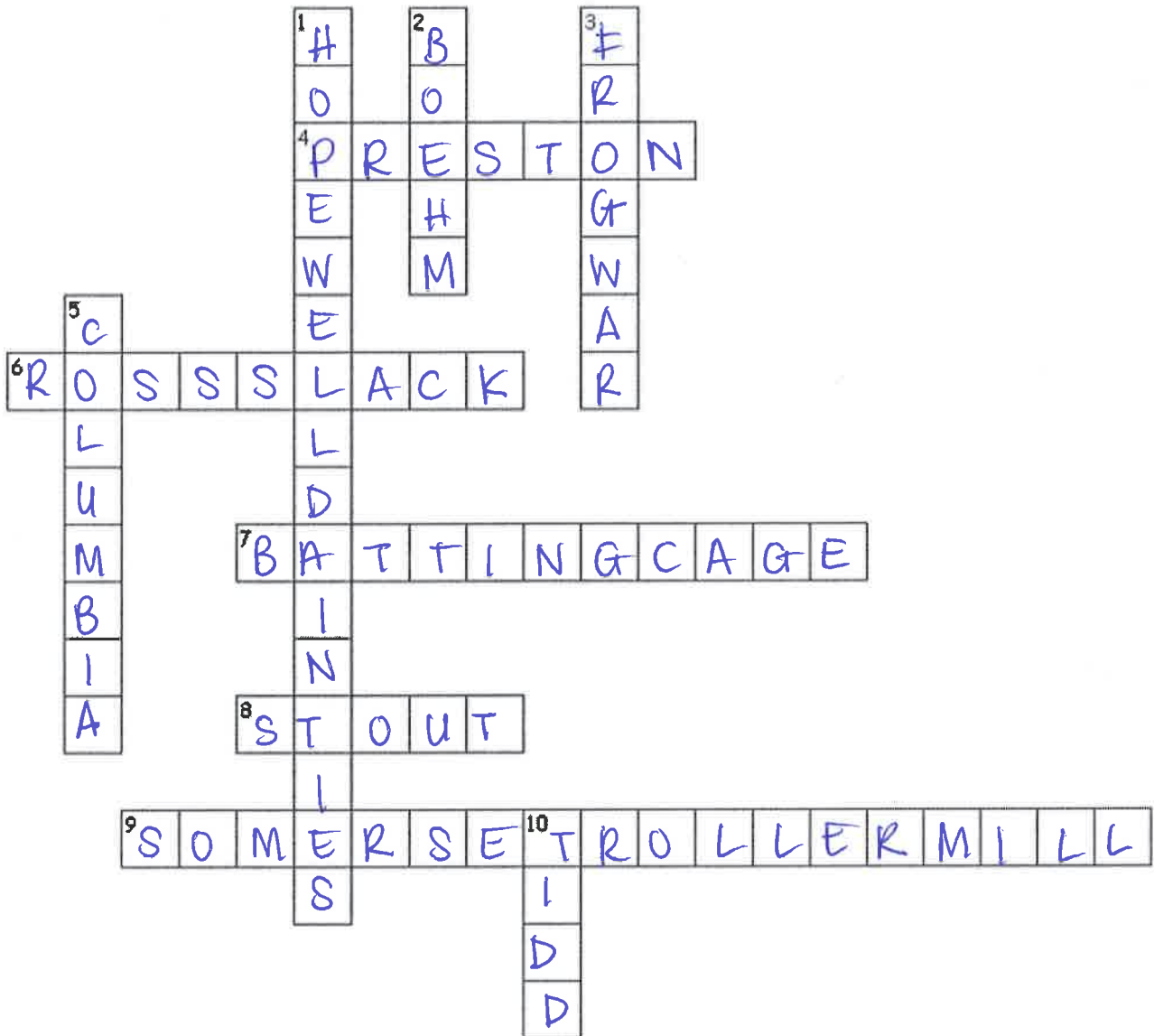


ACROSS

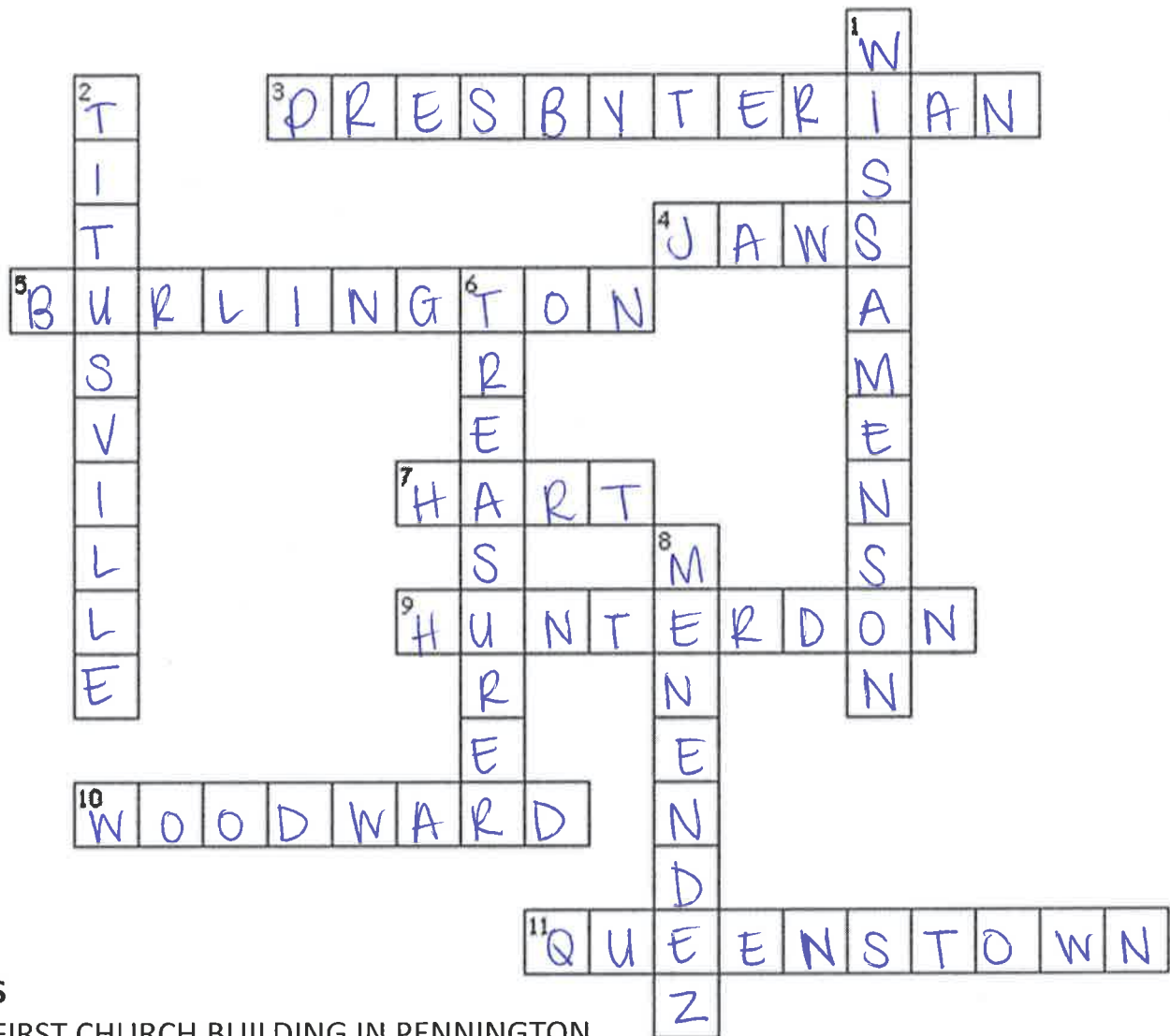

HOPEWELL VALLEY CROSSWORD

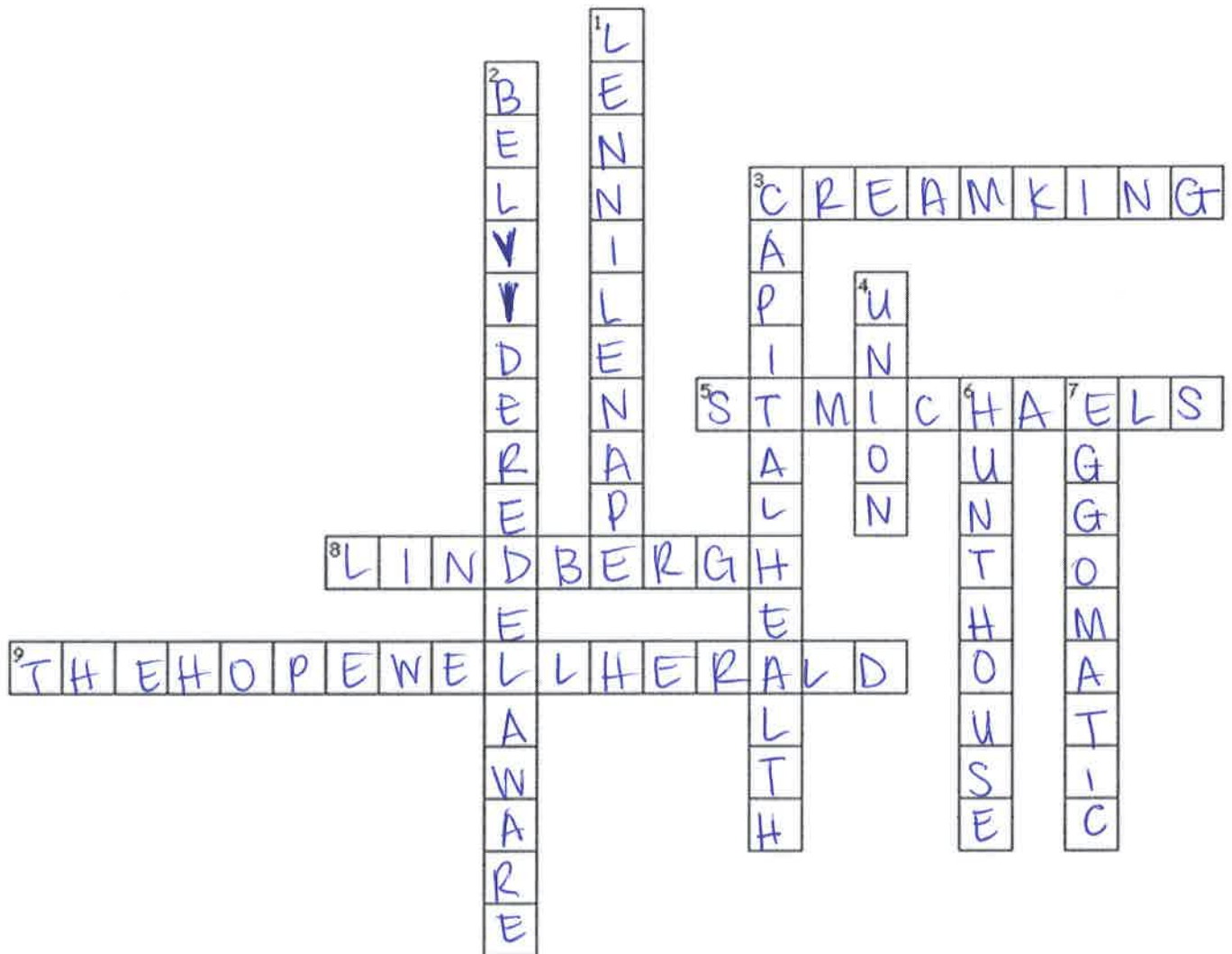
