
**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SENIOR SERVICES COORDINATOR

**SENIOR SERVICES COORDINATOR AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF HOPEWELL, THE
BOROUGH OF PENNINGTON AND THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL**

THIS AGREEMENT is made this _____ day of _____, 2021, between the Borough of Hopewell, a municipal corporation with a business address of 88 East Broad Street, Hopewell, NJ 08525; and the Borough of Pennington, a municipal corporation with a business address of 30 N. Main Street, Pennington, NJ 08534 and the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation with a business address of 201 Washington Crossing-Pennington Road, Titusville, NJ 08560-1410; and

WHEREAS, New Jersey State law authorizes local governmental units to enter shared services agreements with other local governmental units to provide services which each local government is permitted to provide on its own (N.J.S.A. 40:8A-3); and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Hopewell and the Borough of Pennington recognize the valuable contribution of senior residents to their municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell presently provides a Senior Services Coordinator for its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Hopewell and the Borough of Pennington agree for the Hopewell Township Senior Services Coordinator to provide services to Borough seniors for the year 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Borough of Hopewell and the Borough of Pennington agree as follows:

1. The Hopewell Township Senior Services Coordinator will provide senior services to Hopewell Borough and Pennington Borough seniors.
2. The Borough of Hopewell and Borough of Pennington agree to pay to Hopewell Township for Senior Services Coordinator services as follows:
 - a. \$5,000.00 will be paid by the Borough of Hopewell
 - b. \$5,000.00 will be paid by the Borough of Pennington

Payment shall be made to Hopewell Township no later than December 31, 2021.

3. The Senior Service Coordinator shall make a monthly written report to the Borough of Hopewell and the Borough of Pennington regarding programs and services made available to the senior residents from the Boroughs.
4. Modifications to this agreement are permitted only by the mutual written consent of all parties and by the issuance of a written modification, signed and dated by all parties prior to any modifications becoming effective.
