**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF ANNA VAN SCOYOC TO
CONDUCT HOPEWELL VALLEY HERITAGE WEEK**

WHEREAS, application has been made by Anna Van Scoyoc to conduct Hopewell Valley Heritage Week in the Township of Hopewell at Woolsey Park, 203 Washington Crossing-Pennington Road, Titusville, NJ on May 29, 2021 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Hopewell Township Health Officer, the Hopewell Township Police Department, and Hopewell Township Bureau of Fire Safety have reviewed the application and granted their approval to conduct the event and recommend the granting of a permit pursuant to the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Hopewell, Chapter IV, Section 4-3 Festivals and Large Assemblies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. This Resolution shall constitute a permit to conduct Hopewell Valley Heritage Week in accordance with the application submitted by the Anna Van Scoyoc which event is to be held May 29, 2021 at Woolsey Park, 203 Washington Crossing-Pennington Road in Hopewell Township.
2. The Hopewell Valley Heritage Week shall be exempt from the several provisions of 4-3, et seq. (4-3.8 Exemptions. A. Charitable or non-profit organizations) except those provided by 4-3.4, Insurance Requirement.
3. The Fire Official advises that if there is any cooking or tents/canopies 30 x 30 or larger they will require a fire safety permit.
4. The application has been forwarded to Pennington First Aid. The applicant should provide details of what they will do in the event of a medical emergency.
5. The Municipal Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to Anna Van Scoyoc, Hopewell Valley Heritage Week, 36 Orchard Avenue, Pennington, NJ 08534
