**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF MERCER COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, application has been made by Mercer County Stables to conduct a Juneteenth Celebration in the Township of Hopewell at the Mercer County Stables, 431 B Federal City Road, Pennington, New Jersey on June 19, 2021 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. (7:00 a.m.-set-up; 3:00 p.m.-5:00 p.m.-breakdown, clean-up); and

**WHEREAS**, the Hopewell Township Health Officer, the Hopewell Township Police Department, and Hopewell Township Bureau of Fire Safety have reviewed the application and granted their approval to conduct the festival and recommend the granting of a permit pursuant to the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Hopewell, Chapter IV, Section 4-3 Festivals and Large Assemblies.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that:

1. This Resolution shall constitute a permit to conduct a Juneteenth Celebration in accordance with the application submitted by Mercer County Stables, which festival is to be held on June 19, 2021 at 431 B Federal City Road in Hopewell Township.
2. Mercer County Stables shall be exempted from the several provisions of 4-3, et seq. (4-3.8 Exemptions. a. Charitable or non-profit organizations) except those provided by 4-3.4, Insurance Requirement.
3. The Fire Official advises that any cooking or tents/canopies 30 x 30 or larger require a fire safety permit. The application has been forwarded to Pennington First Aid in case of medical emergencies.
4. The Municipal Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Mercer County Stables, 431 B Federal City Road, Pennington, NJ 08534.
